1042-1087
1087-1275 Bishop of Thetford: 4 freemen including Ailmar Walter, son of Grip; Robert de Glanville; and Loernic from Robert Malet's mother; Bishop of Thetford; Abbot of Ely and Roger Bigod; Robert de Wingfield "6 generations before Michael de la Pole, 1384" [vis. Norfolk, 1563, 1589, 1613, p.312]

1276- ? Prior of Thetford. Richard de Brews, and Geoffrey Frombauld, then William Frombauld Fleming

1276-pre-1307 Sir John de Wingfield I, husband of Anne nee Peche - the 9th great-grandparents of "Thomas of York River"

pre-1307-1326 Sir John de Wingfield II, husband of Elizabeth nee Honypott -the 8th-great-grandparents of "Thomas of York River" through their second son, Thomas, and his wife

1326-1362 *Sir John de Wingfield III (Chief of Staff of Edward, the Black Prince), husband of Eleanor Alianore) nee de Glanville, who was a daughter of Sir Gilbert de Glanville, Earl of Suffolk

1362-1388 *Michael de la Pole, 1st Earl of Suffolk (husband of Katharine nee Wingfield, daughter and the only heir of Sir John de Wingfield III)

1389-1397 The Crown (King Richard II)

1397-1415 Michael de la Pole, 2nd Earl of Suffolk

Sep-Oct. 1415 Michael de la Pole, 3rd Earl of Suffolk

1415-1450 William de la Pole, 1st Duke of Suffolk. K.G.

1450-1487 John de la Pole, 2nd Duke of Suffolk. K.G.

1487-1495 The Crown (King Henry VII)

1495-1504 Edmund de la Pole, 4th Earl of Suffolk

1504-1509 The Crown (King Henry VII)

1509-1538 The Crown (King Henry VIII)

1538-1544 Charles Brandon, Duke of Suffolk (grandson of Elizabeth Wfd.)

1544-1571 Sir Henry and Lady Jerningham
