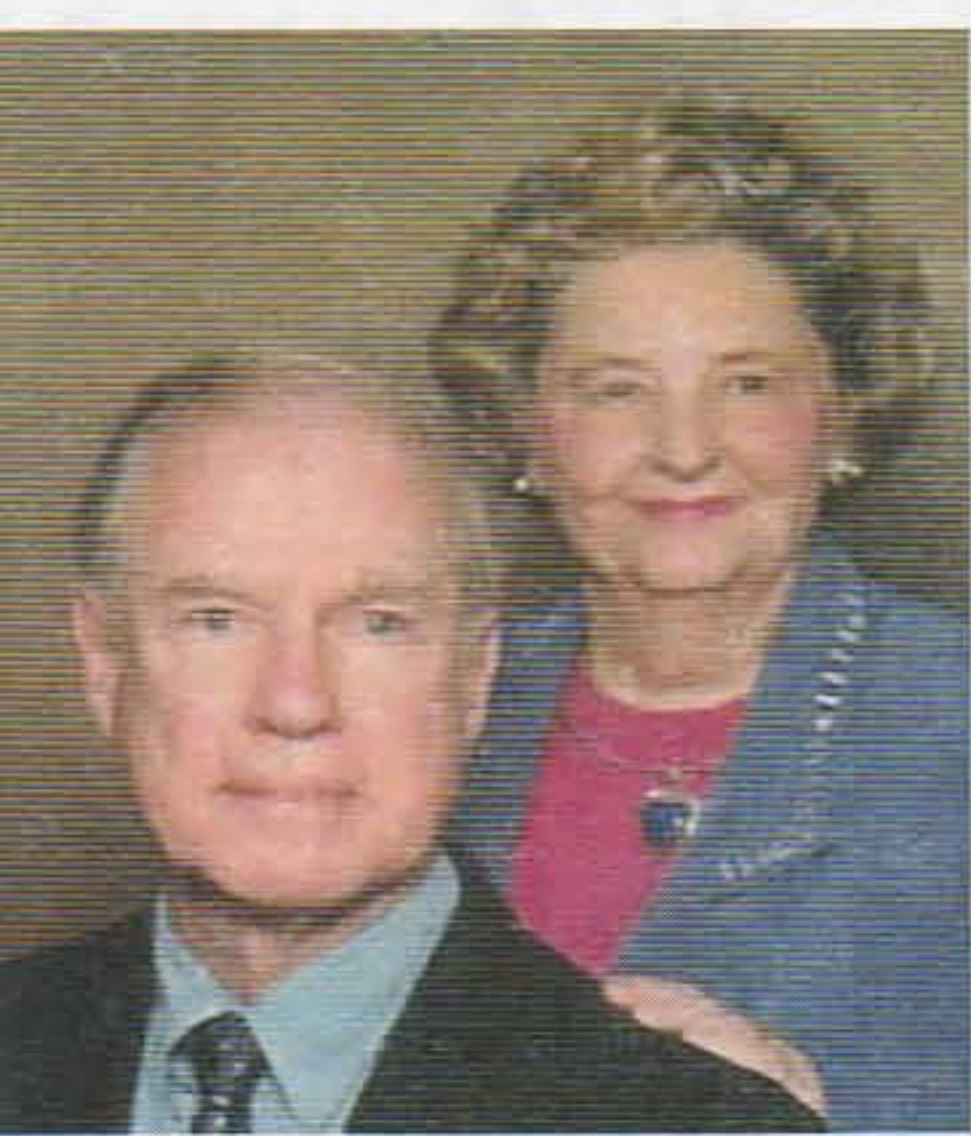


» Dr. Frank Quinby Wingfield and his wife Suzanne Thornton Wingfield passed away during June 2010, Frank from a heart problem and Suzanne from cancer.



'Quin' was born January 31, 1926, in Richmond, Va., the son of the late Frank and Elizabeth Wingfield and the brother of the late Elizabeth Wingfield Rodgers of Richmond.

'Quin' was the beloved husband for 59 years of Suzanne Wingfield. He was a graduate of the Medical College of Virginia and was Chief of Pathology at Riverside Hospital in Newport News, until his retirement.

Quin was a member of the Gloucester Rotary Club. He was active in community agencies such as Meals-on-Wheels. He was the head of the Gloucester Job Referral Program, and was a longtime member of First Presbyterian Church, serving as both deacon and elder.

Suzanne was born August 10, 1927, in Columbus, Ohio, the daughter of the late LeRoy and Irma Thornton of Richmond, Va., and the sister of the late Ronald Thornton of Los Angeles, California. Suzanne was a member of King's Daughters and was an active member of First Presbyterian Church where she was a member of the Women's Circle. She was also a member of the Gloucester Garden Club and was a volunteer at the Riverside Walter Reed Hospital.

They are survived by their three children, Susan W. Soxman, Christopher Q. Wingfield (WFS), and Ann Wingfield Fox, and by five grandchildren.

A memorial service was held at the First Presbyterian Church in Gloucester.
